- Delay on reverse feature is standard, providing less wear and tear on the door system

- All connections have independent connectors that are keyed differently for true socket lock protection, preventing the possibility of miss-wiring the operator and causing damage
- Ability to connect a pushbutton (wire run) to 1,000 feet without the addition of relay kits or special hardware within line of sight of the door
- Easy setup with the push of a button, no need for rewiring
- Auto-tensioning belt system
- RMX-T is equipped with a secondary reversal system, allowing it to reverse to the open limit if it meets an obstruction
- Enhanced diagnostic system: LCD displays current condition code with a 16-character message
- On board open/close/stop button with calibrate/run, set/clear, scroll up/scroll down and backlight for LCD display save time during installation
- Intelligent menu structure that determines presence or absence of optional timer to close module. Auxiliary module shows installers only pertinent information
